    - ii. There will be a 400 SF, 'L' shaped addition south of the existing building.

  - Nelson Yoder described his current business, which is making custom cabinets for contractors and a few new homeowners.
  - c. Joe Bauer asked about dust control. Nelson Yoder explained that they plane and sand in the same building, but the finishing area is in a closed off area.
  - d. After no further discussion, Travis Nachreiner made the motion to recommend approval of the CUP Expansion to the Town Board. The motion was seconded by Joe Bauer. All in favor.
