## Town of Bear Creek Town Board Proceedings of September 13, 2022

The Regular Board Meeting of the Bear Creek Town Board was held at the Bear Creek Town Hall, on September 13, 2022. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Marty McCluskey at 7:00 p.m.

The following members were present: Marty McCluskey, Chairman; Jeff Scallon; and, Steve Emerson, Supervisors.

Others present: Donna Lins, Treasurer; Tim McCluskey, Patrolman; Robbin D'elene; and, Sheila Carver, Clerk.

The minutes of the August 15, 2022 Regular Board Meeting were read by the Clerk. Scallon motioned to approve the minutes. Emerson seconded. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's Report was given by the Treasurer. Scallon motioned to approve the Treasurer's Report. Emerson seconded. Motion carried.

Scallon had no building permits to report. Kim Wright is building a four seasons porch that does not require a permit.

Scallon motioned to approve a temporary liquor license for Holy Angels Parish/St. Patrick's Church for the Fall Festival for September 18, 2022. Emerson seconded. Motion carried. Chairman McCluskey paid the \$10.00 fee and will deliver the license to the church.

The budgeting meeting was set for Wednesday, October 19, 2022 at 7:00 p.m.

Chairman McCluskey has the remainder of the culverts to be installed yet this year. Kaney Road may need more gravel. Hayes Road had a culvert installed today. Garvey Road needs some patching, but seal coating will be addressed in 2023. There is ditching that needs to be done on Bear Valley Road. The broadband project is progressing. The Patrolman is concerned about the broadband line installers destroying shoulders and two culverts they went through on Deitl Road. Chairman McCluskey will check in with the Foreman on the project.

The board approved expenditures totaling \$46,679.37. Also, the loan auto payments were deducted on September 1<sup>st</sup> totaling \$42,518.31.

Scallon motioned to adjourn at 8:07 p.m. Emerson seconded. Motion carried.
